DETAILED PROJECT REPORTS OF ROADS/BRIDGES (D.P.R.) UNDER PM-JANMAN**

M.P.R.R.D.A. a premier agency of Govt. of Madhya Pradesh has successfully completed Rural Roads of about **1,00000** Km. Length. MRRDA intends to undertake the services of the expert consultants for preparation of detailed project report for up-gradation of roads under **PM-JANMAN.(Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adiwasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan Schme)**

Online tenders are invited from the reputed Consultants for survey, investigation and preparation of DPR for up-gradation of Rural and other Roads under **PM-JANMAN** in Madhya Pradesh on e-procurement portal <https://www.mptenders.gov.in> as per details in the table given below:-

1. RFP documents consisting of qualification information and eligibility criterion of bidders, and the set of terms & conditions of contract to be complied with by the consultants can be seen online on the website <https://www.mptenders.gov.in>. RFP documents may be purchased online from <https://www.mptenders.gov.in> as per time schedule mentioned in Key Dates after making online payment of cost of RFP document Rs. **5900/-** for each package and service charges as appearing on the portal through Debit Card/Credit Card or Internet Banking.

2. (a) The amount of **Bid Security** is as appearing in column no. 7 of the table above. The bidders are required to pay Bid Security online plus service charges as appearing on e-procurement portal through Debit / Credit Card, Internet Banking, or System generated Bank Challan for NEFT / RTGS before submission of Bid. Bid Security of disqualified / unsuccessful bidders will be refunded online in the Bank A/c notified by the bidders on the portal at the time of submission of Bids. To avoid last day rush / breakdown in system contractors are advised to ensure payment of Bid Security at least one day in advance before the end date of Bid Submission. Department will not be responsible if contractor fails to pay Bid Security due to Server / Power failure or any other reason.
- (b) The bidders are required to upload with technical bid, online scanned copy of the affidavit strictly on prescribed form (Annexure 'A' of this NIT) affirming correctness of information furnished. If affidavit is not on prescribed form, bidder will be disqualified & financial bid of such bidder will not be opened. There is no need to submit the original copy of affidavit.
3. To qualify for award of work consultants should have successfully completed preparation of D.P.R. of any one **Road of Estimated** cost more than Rs. 150 crores or minimum 200 Kms. of rural roads in any one year during last five years. Other conditions for award of work will be as per RFP document.
4. **No consultants will be allotted work of more than two packages Work awarded after 01/07/2023 and presently incomplete will be taken into account while deciding number of packages to be allotted.**
5. **If lowest rates offered by two or more bidders are equal, fresh limited tenders will be invited from the bidders who have quoted same rates on e-tender portal for taking decision on the tender.**
6. **The estimates for Road works including structures are to be prepared on SSR issued by MPRRDA effective from 05.11.2019 and those for bridges more than 15 m. length on PWD bridge SOR effective from 25/03/2022 and amended up to date of NIT**
7. The financial proposals are invited per Km. of road length inclusive of all Cross Drainage works/Bridges/VCW/FCWs. (excluding exploratory boring for bridges, rates for boring shall be applicable as per **PWD bridge SOR effective from 25/03/2022 and amended up to date of NIT**). Estimates of concrete road shall also be prepared for such road as may be identified by the PIU. DPR should comply all the requirements of standard DPR template attached as **Annexure-II**.
8. The time limit for completion of consultancy service is **03 Months** including rainy season from the date of Work Order. **Clause 8 of RFP document (TOR) may be treated to have been amended accordingly.**
DPR should be submitted in batches as per priority decided by GM PIU and the whole work is to be completed within the time limit specified above.
9. Road length given is tentative. There may be variation up to $\pm 50\%$.
10. **Special Condition which are to be strictly followed by consultant are given in the Annexure-'B' to this NIT.**
11. Last date for submission of completed offers is as given in Key Dates. The Technical Evaluation will be done first and financial offers of only qualified bidders will be opened in the presence of consultant(s)/representative(s) who choose to be present. The decision of the competent authority in regard to technical evaluation shall be final, binding and conclusive.
12. Certificate of client that work was satisfactory completed within the given/extended time limit should be attached.
13. If During execution of work, due to incorrect provision in the DPR, deviation more than 10% of the estimated cost is required (even if package is completed within the sanctioned

cost), 20% amount of final installment of consultancy fee will be forfeited as penalty. If deviation is more than 25% of the estimated cost consultant will be black listed for participation in consultancy tenders (both DPR & SQC) & 20% amount of final installment of consultancy fee will be forfeited.

14. At any time before the submission of the proposals, the Client may, for any reason, whether at its own initiative or in response to a clarification requested by an invited consulting firm, modify the Documents by amendment. The amendment will be notified on e-procurement portal <https://www.mptenders.gov.in>. The client may at his discretion extend the deadline for submission of the proposals which will also be notified on this e-procurement portal.
15. ***Before award of work consultant and proposed key personnel may be called, if required, for discussion on the technical proposal, the proposed methodology (work plan), staffing and for interviewing each of the key personal (TL/PE) to ascertain their overall suitability/ availability for the assignment. If proposed TL/PE is not found suitable for the assignment, consultant shall be given at least one more opportunity to present the alternate TL/PE of desired qualification and competence. Proposal of the consultants, who fail to provide suitable TL/PE even after being given adequate opportunity, shall not to be considered even if it is lowest for the particular package.**
16. Documents to be uploaded with the bid online are given in Annexure-C to this NIT.
17. Tender conditions, Acceptance letter as given in Annexure-D is also to be uploaded.
18. **Taxes – The rates quoted by the consultant are deemed to be inclusive of the sales and other levies, royalties, cess, toll. Taxes of Central and State Government, local bodies and authorities except GST, that the consultant will have to pay for the performance of this Contract. GST as applicable at the time of payment to the consultant shall be paid separately. consultant will have to get themselves registered under GST and quote GSTIN in their bids. The Employer will perform such duties in regard to the deduction of such taxes at source as per applicable law.**

SPECIAL CONDITION

1. These are existing roads, and in some roads widening and up-gradation, as per traffic intensity will be required. Such roads are to be identified in consultation with GM concerned. For such roads, a strip plan showing the sides, identifying left or right, for widening of carriage way and top width separately, should be submitted with DPR.
2. Existing crust thickness available for construction at every 200 m. with cross section should also be submitted. Geo Tagged Photographs at specified intervals along with KML file of alignment should also to be attached with DPR.
3. DPR should include
 - (i) Plan showing toe width at every 25 m. and at curve @ 10 m.
 - (ii) Design of curve /Horizontal /Vertical/ with design & land width required.
 - (iii) CC pavement location and design.
 - (iv) Road safety/social and environmental safe guard issues are to be identified and incorporated in the DPR. Similarly issues of Road Safety, Social and Environmental Safeguards are to be addressed.
4. The consultant has to demonstrate the software which he will use for calculation of quantities required for construction of roads, before drawing the agreement.
5. Consultant has to establish fully equipped lab for testing of soil and material to be used for construction at PIU level before starting the survey work. The following minimum equipment should be available in the lab of consultant.
 - a. All sieves required for grain size analysis.
 - b. Equipment required for test of consistency limits of soil.
 - c. Proctor compaction test kit.
 - d. C.B.R. testing Machine.
6. The consultant has to test at least two soil sample for every km of road and at least two sample of each quarry suggested for construction material. Consultant will take samples of soil in the presence of PIU Engineers authorized by General Manager.
7. Consultant will examine adequacy and soundness of the existing bridge/CD structures and suggest widening, strengthening, rehabilitation or construction of new structure as may be necessary. Consultant proposal will contain full technical/ hydraulic data in support of his suggestion.
 - 7.1 Separate drawing/design and estimate of all culverts/bridges between 15m. to 60 m. length (between the faces of abutments), is to be submitted after conducting necessary survey and soil investigations with complete hydraulic data and calculations in the DPR.
 - 7.2 Location of all existing culverts/bridges is to be given in the DPR.
 - 7.3 Where a major bridge is proposed, consultant will submit proposal after conducting necessary survey with complete hydraulic data and calculation in the DPR. For Foundation Investigation Consultant shall take 100 mm dia exploratory bore at four locations two in the center and two in other suitable locations as per side conditions in all types of strata as per IRC-78- 1983 and section 2400 of specifications. Consultant will have to attach, the site plan indicating location and depth of each bore. Rates for boring shall be applicable as per **PWD bridge SOR**

effective from 25/03/2022 and amended up to date of NIT. More than 60 m. length bridges will be out of the scope of the consultant. Chief General Manager will decide the length of bridges if it is more than 60 m.

8. Consultant has to submit the road wise detailed programme of their survey party, Pavement Engineer, Structural Engineer, Environmental expert, Social expert & Road Safety expert visit and get the approval of General Manager. So that PIU Engineer may also accompany them and verify the work done or proposed as per site condition.
9. DPR should include :
 - (i) Detail of Transit walk survey and consultation community with documentation and photographs.
 - (ii) Geo Tagged Site photographs at 100 m. interval & KML file.
 - (iii) Traffic survey data.
 - (iv) Road safety measures required.
 - (v) Realistic/proper estimate of Utility shifting, Electric line raising, pole shifting etc as per requirement.
10. These conditions will prevail over the conditions of TOR / DPR Template if they are contradictory to each other.
11. ***The estimates for Road works including structures are to be prepared on SSR issued by MPRRDA effective from 05.11.2019 and those for bridges more than 15 m. length on PWD bridge SOR effective from 25/03/2022 and amended up to date of NIT.**
12. ***Consultants will be subject to disqualification and black listing if it is found that they have made misleading and take representations in the forms, statements, affidavits and attachments submitted in proof of the qualification requirements and to secure contract by unfair mean.**
